Protecting your health

1. Keep an updated list of your medications, drug allergies, and emergency contact numbers in your purse or wallet.
2. Review the drugs you are taking, including herbal and nutritional supplements, with your doctor or pharmacist on a regular basis.
3. Read and follow the safety instructions included with your drugs.
4. Take prescription drugs that are prescribed only for you.
5. Do not take expired medications.

Tips for saving money

1. Ask your doctor about generic drugs. On average cost 20 to 70 percent less and produce the same results as comparable brand-name drugs.
2. Use your card at participating pharmacies to receive immediate discounts on prescription drugs.

Introducing Your Prescription Drug Discount Card Program

This program, brought to you by AdvancePCS, allows you easily save money on prescription drugs, **This is not insurance.** Rather, it is a way for you to get discounts on prescription drugs at most pharmacies.

- Save an average of 20 percent off prescription drugs. (save the most on generic drugs.)
- Use your card at most pharmacies nationwide.
- Get discounted pricing on commonly used prescription drugs at participating pharmacies.

About Your Savings

Your cost for medication will be the lower of: (1) the discount price offered through this program or (2) the pharmacy's retail price. This means you are assured the lowest price in that store, at the time you purchase the medication.

Participating Pharmacies

The list included shows several pharmacies that accept your discount card. To find out if a pharmacy not listed here accepts your card, call the pharmacy directly.

Discounts are available only at participating pharmacies.

Fill your prescriptions in three easy steps:

1. **Select a pharmacy** – choose a participating pharmacy. **Important:** discounted pricing is only available at participating pharmacies with this program.
2. **Present your discount card and prescription to your pharmacist** – If you do not show your card with your prescription, you might not receive discounted pricing.
3. **Pay for your medication** – Your pharmacist will tell you the cost of your medication.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I use my card to get discounts on over-the-counter products and non-prescription medications?

Not usually. However, discounts ARE available for many diabetic supplies.

What if I lose my discount card or need to order extra cards?

Request additional cards from your program administrator.
